Extend your legacy, by indicating joining the prestigious ASSP Foundation 1911 Founders Society by adding the ASSP Foundation as a beneficiary for a portion of your estate, 401k or even life insurance policy. After ensuring your loved ones are taken care of, consider joining your fellow ASSP leaders by adding the ASSP Foundation as a partial beneficiary.

The 1911 Founders Society is named to honor the year that ASSP was officially launched, just months after one of the deadliest workplace disasters in U.S. history—the Triangle Shirtwaist Factory fire, which killed 146 workers in a New York City garment factory in 1911. We are humbled and honored that you have chosen to take advantage of this opportunity to impact the profession beyond your career.

How do I make a legacy gift?

It is quite simple to create a legacy gift. You can do any of the following:

Add the American Society of Safety Professionals Foundation as a beneficiary within your will. Some will note a specific amount or percentage of your estate with stipulations that it be disbursed to the American Society of Safety Professionals Foundation. Some sample language:

- *Specific Amount: I give, devise, and bequeath \$ _____ to the American Society of Safety Professionals Foundation (EIN 36-6145045).*
- *Percentage Bequest: I give, devise, and bequeath _____ % of my gross estate to the American Society of Safety Professionals Foundation (EIN 36-6145045).*
- *Residuary Bequest: I give, devise and bequeath the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate to the American Society of Safety Professionals Foundation (EIN 36-6145045).*

Add the ASSP Foundation as a beneficiary in your life insurance policy. As with the will, you can indicate either a dollar figure or percentage to be disbursed to the ASSP Foundation.

- *To implement your wishes, please contact your life insurance agent or company and obtain and complete the needed change of beneficiary form.*

Add the ASSP Foundation as a beneficiary in your 401k. Same as the other two options, you can indicate a percentage or dollar figure.

- *To implement your wishes, please contact your 401k administrator. Quite often, this can be done online through the 401k portal for your organization's program.*

Once you have made your decision and implemented your legacy gift, please complete the form below and return it to the ASSP Foundation.
